

Mrs. Wise’s Spelling Homework Options
Grade 2

Students will receive a new spelling list each Monday. On Monday morning, students will copy their spelling words in their agendas.

Students must complete 4 different spelling activities by Friday, the day of their spelling test. Students may choose to do one activity each night (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) or students may prefer to complete more than one activity on one night. Homework journals will be checked on Fridays.

Students must choose their spelling activities from the table below, and complete the assignment in their homework journal.
